Disc Golf Rules:

- 1. Disc Golf is played like ball golf using a flying disc. One point is counted each time the disc is thrown and when a penalty is incurred. The object is to acquire the lowest score.
- 2. TEE THROWS Tee throws must be completed within or behind the designated tee area.
- 3. LIE The spot on or directly underneath the spot the previous throw landed.
- 4. **THROWING ORDER** After teeing off the player whose disc is farthest from the basket always throws first. The player with the least amount of throws on the previous hole is the first to tee off on the next hole.
- 5. **FAIRWAY THROWS** Fairway throws must be made with the foot closest to the basket on the lie. The other foot may be no closer to the basket than the lie. A run up and normal follow through are allowed.
- 6. MANDITORY THROW A mandatory throw is one or more designated trees or poles which must be passed on the outside when approaching the basket. Until the mandatory object is passed, the closest foot to the mandatory object must be on the lie when the disc is released. Hole #6 has a mandatory throw to the right of the first tree
- 7. PUTT THROW Within 10 Yards of the pole, a player may not step past the point of their lie in making his putt throw. Falling or jumping putts are not allowed.
- 8. **UNPLAYABLE LIE** Any disc that comes to rest above or below the playing surface. After declaring an unplayable lie the disc must be thrown from directly below or above the unplayable lie. (No penalty)
- 9. **OUT OF BOUNDS** A throw which lands out of bounds must be played from the point at which the disc went out of bounds. (1 throw penalty) Out of bounds includes: on or over the sidewalk bordering the park; the parking lot; in or over the water hazard on holes 14, 16, 17, and F; in the water hazard on hole B; anywhere outside the outer border fence.
- 10. COURSE COUTESY Don't throw until the players ahead of you are out of range. Don not make excessive noise while others are playing. Please leave the course cleaner than you found it. THANK YOU!!
