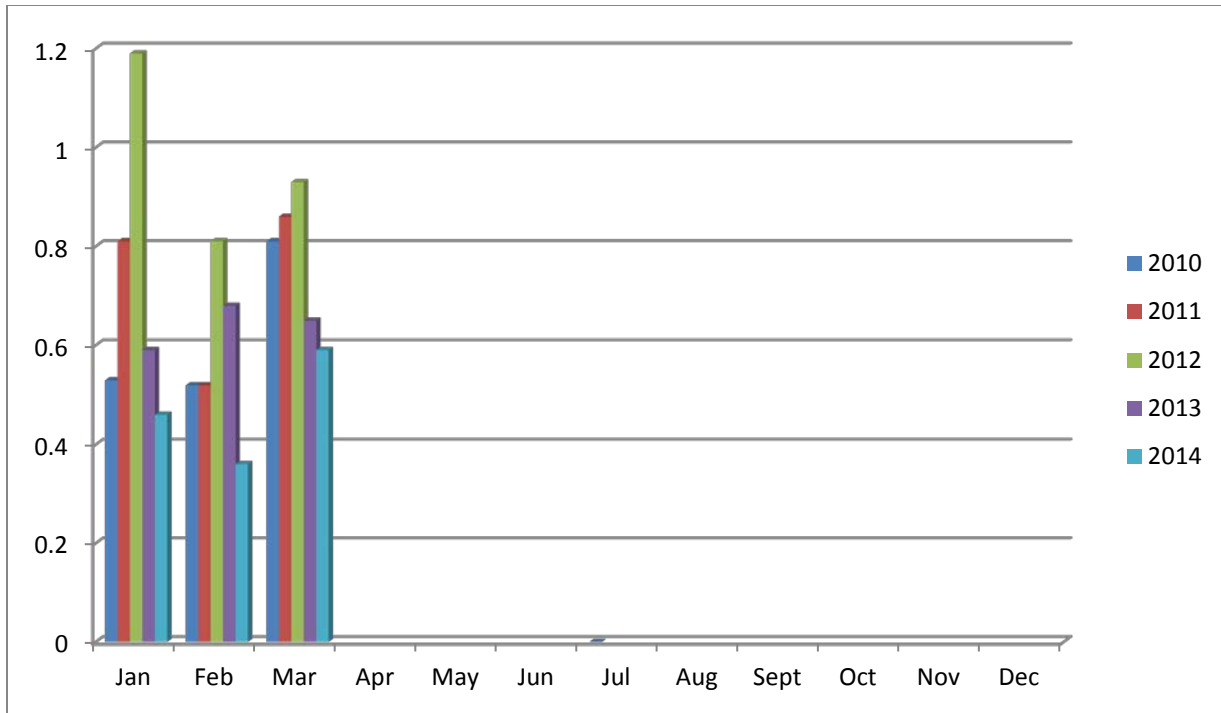
### **SRO STATS**

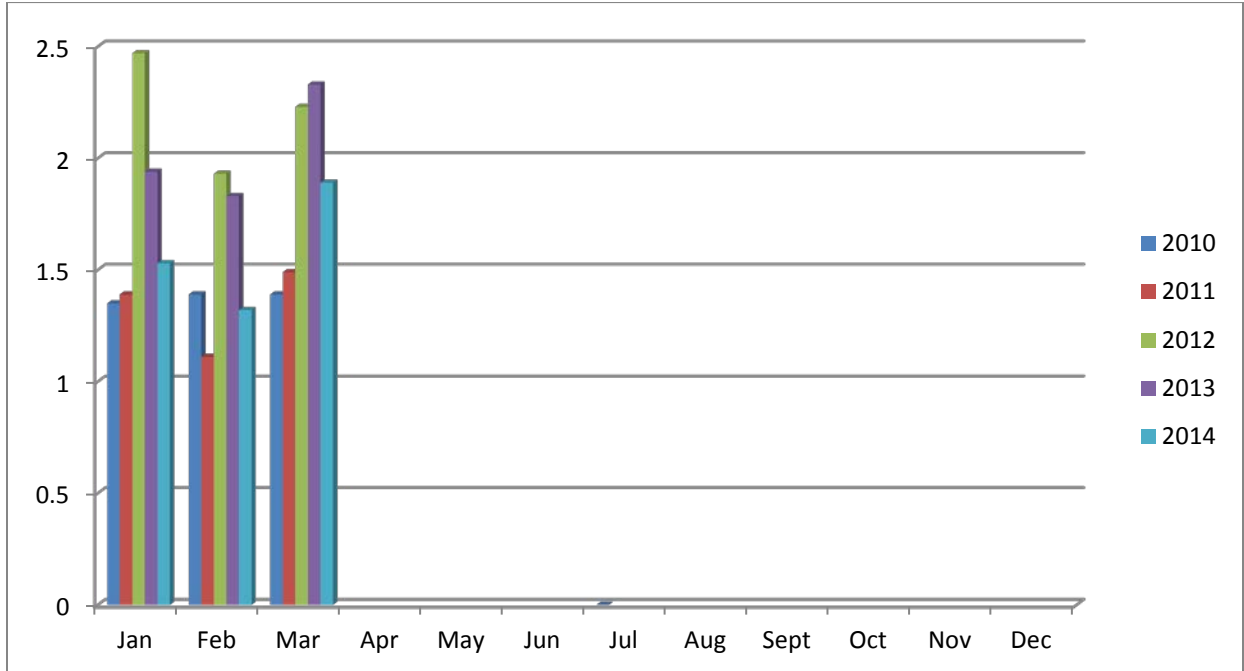
