Re: Bids for Ultraviolet Disinfection Project



Bids were received on Thursday, November 13, 2014 for installation of an ultraviolet (UV) disinfection system at the wastewater treatment plant. Following is the summary of the bids received:

Davis Construction	\$ 493,532.00
Grand River Construction Co.	\$ 522,000.00
Skye Contracting Co.	\$ 536,500.00
RCL Construction	\$ 544,400.00
Gerace Construction	\$ 548,500.00
Triangle Associates, Inc.	\$ 549,000.00
LD Docsa Associates, Inc.	\$ 659,000.00

Our engineers for the project have worked with Davis Construction in the past and have no issues with them. Therefore, based on the bid price and previous work history, we are recommending that the contract be awarded to Davis Construction in the amount of \$493,532.00. The work is in the water and sewer budget and should be completed this winter, weather dependent.


Dear Ms. Gilson:

Seven bids were received at 2:00 p.m., on November 13, 2014, for the *Charlotte WWTP UV System* project. All bids were reviewed and checked for accuracy. Enclosed is a copy of the tabulation of bids.

Davis Construction submitted the low bid for the project in the amount of \$493,532.00. The engineer's estimate was \$540,000.00.

We have discussed this project with Davis Construction, and they feel comfortable with their price, and we feel comfortable with their work plan to accomplish the job and the UV Equipment they have selected. The low bidder has a satisfactory performance record on previous projects, and we recommend that a contract be awarded to Davis Constructed in the amount of \$493,532.00.
