D. <u>DISCUSSION REGARDING SIGN</u> <u>INSTALLATION AT THE FORMER ARMORY</u> BUILDING:

E. APPROVE AIRPORT RUNWAY REHABILITATION PROJECT CHANGE IN SCOPE:

City Manager Guetschow stated that this project provides for modest maintenance in keeping the runway in great shape. He also explained that new numbers need to be painted on the runway which can be done in conjunction with the project.

Councilmember Conway moved, supported by Dyer to approve the Airport Runway Rehabilitation Project change in Scope as presented. Carried. 6 Yes. 0 No.

CITY ATTORNEY REPORT: None.

<u>CITY MANAGER REPORT:</u> City Manager Guetschow stated that himself and Attorney Hitch have met with the State Treasury Department and school officials regarding the O-I funds and expect them to reach a conclusion soon in the matter.

He stated that the house at 329 S. Lincoln Street has been sold and expects that it will be demolished soon.
