The following is my report to the City Council on several issues in which our office has been engaged since the last Council meeting:

- 1. <u>Personnel Issues</u>. The motion from the prosecutor's office seeking to forfeit a portion of Carrie Bowerman's retirement benefit has been adjourned to November 18, 2015. The prosecutor is seeking information from the Michigan Employee Retirement System. I have been in contact with representatives of MERS trying to obtain documents so no testimony would be necessary. I will keep the Council apprized as this matter proceeds.
- 2. <u>In Mold Solutions Tax Delinquency</u>. I have been working with the City Manager and City Treasurer regarding issues involving In Mold Solutions and a tax delinquency due to the failure of its predecessor, Woolin Products, and In Mold to pay certain industrial facilities taxes owed to the City. I will keep the Council apprized as this matter progresses.
