NEW BUSINESS:

A. PUBLIC HEARING- ORDINANCE TO AMEND LANGUAGE FOR MX-1 MIXED USE ZONING.: Public Hearing Opened at: 7:04 P.M.

Community Development Director Myrkle explained that this is the same request that was approved by the board at the February meeting. He gave an overview of the MX-1 Mixed Use Ordinance and explained the ordinance language for the new commission members. He explained that there is a sale pending on 218 N. structures have been demolished on this property and the new owners intend to build a new building to house the vehicles that they are doing maintenance on so that the vehicles will not be sitting out in the open. It is currently zoned I-1 Light Industrial and a conditional use permit will be needed to permit this construction.
