SUBJECT: Final Approval of Resolution 2017-15

DATE: March 10, 2017

During Council's previous meeting, you discussed Resolution 2017-15 that would establish a schedule of street reconstruction and rehabilitation projects. During debate on the resolution two amendments to the motion approving the resolution were introduced. One, proposed by Council member Bahmer, failed. A second amendment proposed by Council member Ridge was approved.

Unfortunately, I failed to adequately perform my duties as unofficial parliamentarian. As a consequence, no action was taken on the amended motion.

Robert's Rules of Order makes an allowance for such circumstances. It provides as follows: "If a question was pending at the time of adjournment, it is taken up as the first item under unfinished business...resuming the question at exactly where it was previously interrupted. "

Since we do not have a section of the agenda entitled "unfinished business," I have placed this matter as the first item under "Expedited Resolutions and Ordinances." I have rewritten Resolution 2017-15 to reflect the approved amendment. While it is anticipated that Council would take final action on this resolution, other amendments are in order.
