SUBJECT: Street Improvement Program

DATE: March 10, 2017

At the previous Council meeting, a resolution was passed identifying the 100 block of E. Lovett Street as the reconstruction project to be undertaken during the 2017 construction season. Council has not yet settled on a plan for the remainder of the six-year period on which we have been focused.

In an effort to help move Council closer to consensus on the matter, Mayor Lewis asked that I prepare resolutions for each of the three plans that have been under consideration. These resolutions are attached. As you will see, they all have identical resolution numbers, on the assumption that Council will adopt only one. Following the resolution number is an identifier that is unique to each that relates to a particular Major Street Fund cash flow scenario. These resolutions are described below.

Resolution 2017-27 (v. 1a). This resolution is based on the cash flow scenario developed by the administrative staff. It was modified to reflect that decision of Council to undertake E. Lovett Street this year. Under this scenario, as you recall, the reconstruction of State Street falls near the end of the period for which we are planning.

Resolution 2017-27 (v. 3). This resolution is based on Council member Bahmer's proposal. In brief, it accelerates the construction of State Street by borrowing \$400,000 from the Local Development Finance Authority and foregoing two years of rehabilitation projects.

Resolution 2017-27 (v. 6). This resolution is based on a plan proposed by Mayor Lewis. Like Mr. Bahmer's plan, it moves State Street to 2018 along with Lincoln Street but retains the rehabilitation projects. It accomplishes this by utilizing \$1.2 million in general obligation debt. The resolution includes directing staff to prepare ballot language for a bond issue and also for a Charter amendment that would establish restrictions on the use of the Owens-Brockway settlement funds.

unlimited tax general obligation bonds to be used for the Lincoln-State street reconstruction project in 2018.
