The following is my report to the City Council on issues in which our office has been engaged since the last Council meeting:

- 1. Roberts Real Estate of Charlotte, LLC v City of Charlotte. The record on appeal has been filed along with the transcript, and I am now awaiting the filing of the brief on appeal by the attorneys for Roberts Real Estate. I will then have 21 days within which to file the City's brief.
- 2. Hamman v Michigan Employees Retirement System ("MERS"). Mr. Hamman, who recently retired, is challenging a determination made by MERS that he was not entitled to any service hours for the work that he performed while at the City of Jackson. I have filed an appearance and will attend the hearing in order to protect the interests of the City.
- 3. <u>Miscellaneous Contracts and Easements</u>. I have been reviewing easements and contracts as submitted by the City for my review. They principally come from the Department of Public Works. Upon my review, all of the presented contracts appear to be acceptable.
