Dear City Council -

The Michigan Nordic Fire Festival is requesting permission to sell and consume alcohol at 615 West Shepherd Street, otherwise known as the 'sledding hill' area, south of Lincoln Park during its festival on February 22, 23, and 24, 2019. Per Council Policy, we are submitting the following information:

- 1.) We intend to use a 4' X 100' tent as well as perimeter fencing as required (copy of layout plan attached).
- 2.) We have hired paid, professional security services to provide security both inside the tent and around the perimeter area, as outlined in the attached security contract. In addition, there will be volunteer staff and trained servers present at all times.
- 3.) This will be a 'beer tent' style event with entertainment.
- 4.) We have worked with the Charlotte Police Department to plan this event, and to meet the requirements of the Michigan Liquor Control Commission (copy of license application attached).
- 5.) We are carrying insurance in excess of that required by the City (copy of insurance certificate attached).

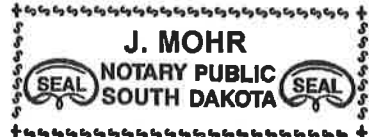

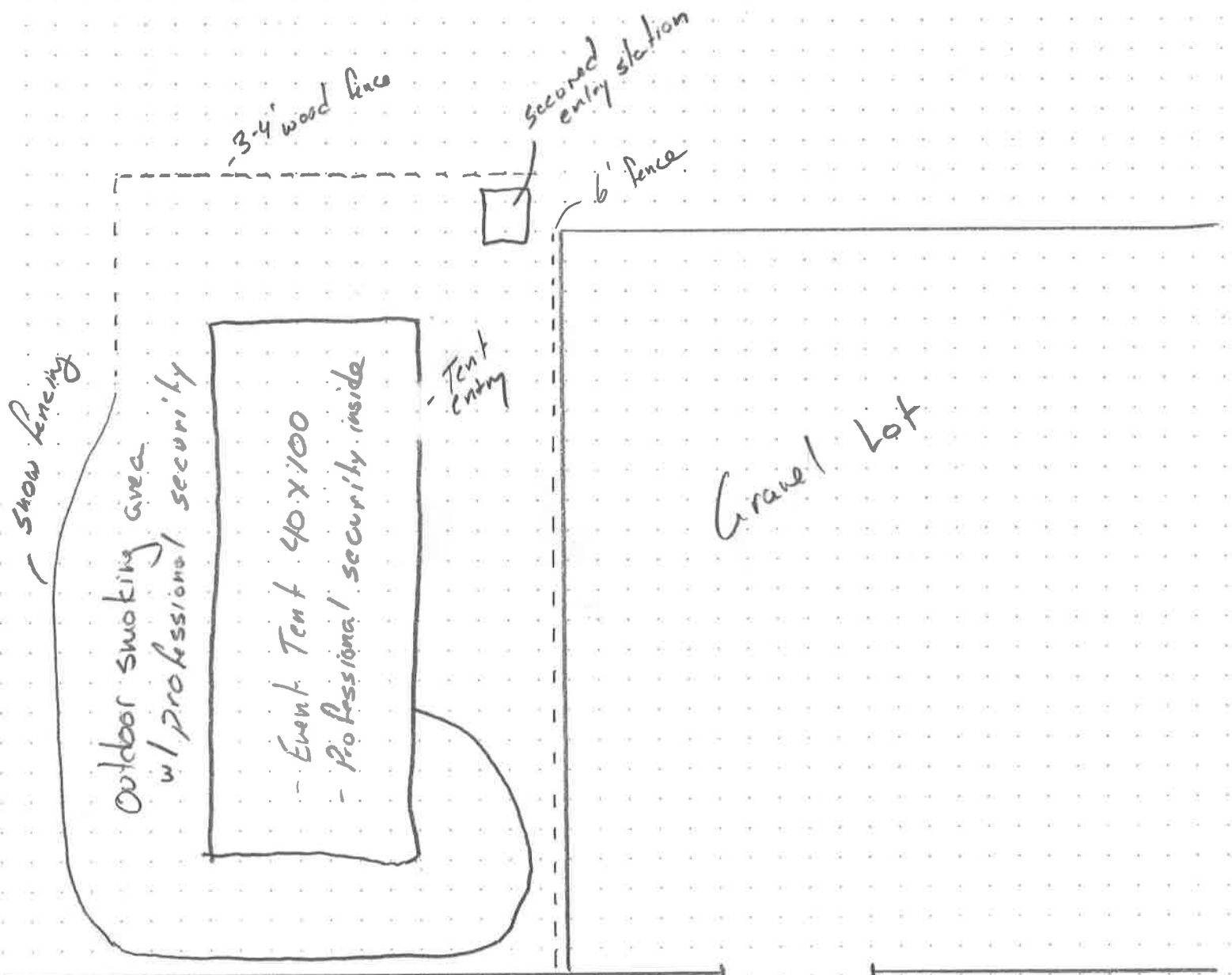
