The City Clerk is hereby directed to cause notice of the time and place of the hearing to be published once in The County Journal, the official newspaper of the City of Charlotte, not less than ten (10) days prior to the date of said hearing and shall further cause notice of said hearing to be sent by first class mail to each owner of property subject to assessment, as indicated by the records in the City Assessor's Office as shown on the general tax roll of the City, at least (10) full days before the time of said hearing, said notice to be mailed to the addresses shown on said general tax rolls of the City.
