Re: Special events on September 12

On your Council agenda for this Monday evening are two resolutions of approval for use of public space for events on Saturday, September 12.

One event is a craft and car show organized by the Chamber of Commerce as a fundraiser on behalf of Crosswalk Teen Center. The event would take place on Harris Street. The other is a vendor and entertainment event planned for City Parking Lot No. 4, and organized by a group of approximately 10 downtown businesses led by Reflections Boutique.

Since many of the regular events that might have taken place this summer were cancelled or postponed due to the Coronavirus shutdown, some groups have been working on smaller, fill-in events that can be organized in a short time, but still have a positive community impact.

The purpose of the two resolutions is to authorize the use of public space, identify the responsible parties and require compliance with executive orders regarding Covid-19.

There are two resolutions, because while they are taking place the same day, they are separate events.
