The following is my report to the City Council on issues in which our office has been engaged since the last Council meeting:

- 1. <u>City Manager separation agreement.</u> I have had several conversations with the Mayor and legal counsel for Gregg Guetschow, Karen Schneider. The Mayor will update Council further on this issue at the Council meeting.
- **2.** <u>City of Charlotte v. Brian Dunn.</u> On Tuesday, August 11, our Motion for Summary Disposition will be heard by Judge Maurer. If the court grants the motion, the case will end in our favor on that time. If not, there will be further discovery and we will prepare for a trial.
- 3. <u>Tully Brown Drive Paving Agreement</u>. I received a request from Amy Gilson to prepare an agreement to memorialize the obligation of Maple Hill Cemetery to pay for two-thirds of the paving amount. If not on this week's agenda, it will be coming to Council fairly quickly.
