RE: Volunteer Firefighter Stipend

Manager LaPere,

Per our conversation regarding Assistant Fire Chief (volunteer capacity) stipend amount, I am writing you this memo and request that an approved amount is set for this volunteer position.

History-

The volunteer firefighter stipends were approved for the city to issue payment to the volunteer firefighters directly in the last quarter of 2020 (effective 1-1-2021). Further, during that request, the Fire Chief provided information and the budgeted amount, City Council may remember that an Assistant Fire Chief has not been paid at the volunteer level since 2012. In 2013 a full-time member of the department was nominated & elected Assistant Fire Chief by the Volunteers and did not receive the stipend from 2013 to 2021 because of the full-time employment as a Fire Captain. By doing both rolls, the member saved the City & Rural Fire Assn. several thousand dollars every year.

The amount last paid, known by memory was \$2500.00 every three months. (Per quarter)

Current-

As of May 1st 2021, the Assistant Fire Chief has been filled by a volunteer member of the fire department. This member fills in during an absence of the Fire Chief and the stipend amount should reflect for these extra duties.

Assistant Chief Sanders should receive this stipend and recommend that the set amount stays at the same rate as we recall from the past, (\$2,500.00 per quarter).
