Christmas Tree Collection

The City of Charlotte will be picking up Christmas trees the week of January 3, 2022. Please place your trees at the curb by 7:00 a.m. Monday for pickup during the week. Christmas trees must have all decorations removed and cannot be in a plastic bag.

City Hall Holiday Closures
