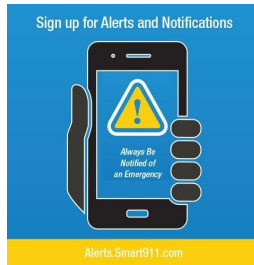
Commercial Marihuana Licensing–

Public Hearings: The Planning Commission will hold a public hearing on **August 1 at 7pm** for residents to provide comments and feedback on a proposed Zoning Ordinance that would create three, overlay districts where the commercial marihuana uses would be permitted. On **August 21 at 7pm**, City Council will conduct a public hearing to receive feedback from residents on a proposed Ordinance that would allow and regulate the commercial marihuana permitting process.
